As a host family, we will...

- read and abide by the Host Family Information Guide which includes important dates, host family responsibilities, and important contact information.
- provide two separate beds either in a shared room or in two private rooms with access to a bathroom and shower (may be shared).
- host both Shlichim for two consecutive weeks (one session).
- provide all meals, including daily lunch at camp, and provide opportunities for Shlichim to purchase groceries from Kroger with a gift card supplied by the Weinstein JCC.
- help the Shlichim feel "at home" and "part of our family" by coordinating family dinners, taking them on sightseeing trips and activities, help with laundry, etc.
- attend a "Meet the Shlichim" happy hour on Wednesday, May 22 from 5-6PM.
- ensure transportation for the Shlichim TO and FROM camp according to the schedule below at one of these designated locations :
